c-RUST **Rust Converter/Primer**

Product Description- *VersaFlex c-RUST* is a specially formulated, low solids, single component, rust converter. Its low viscosity contributes to ease of application on steel and other ferrous substrates. **c-RUST** provides a superior primer for application of *VersaFlex* polyurea products.

Uses- **c-RUST** rust converter/primer may be used with all *VersaFlex* rapid curing polyurea sealants and spray coatings systems. It is designed for use in both interior and exterior priming situations.

Chemical Composition- Water-based active rust converter.

Mixing- **c-RUST** is a single component product. Prior to use shake container or stir for one to two minutes.

Shelf Life- One year, in original, unopened factory containers, under normal storage conditions of 55°F to 95°F. Protect from freezing.

Safety- Dilute with water for clean-up.

Application Recommendations- **c-RUST** should be applied by low-pressure sprayer, airless sprayer, roller or brush. Apply at 200 - 500 s.f. per gallon, depending on surface condition.

Preparation and Installation- Ferrous substrate must be clean and sound prior to installation of **c-RUST**.
